Footnotes

CEE'S THE YEAR chased inside then came out into the backstretch, continued alongside a rival stalking the pace, came three deep into the stretch, bid three wide in midstretch under left handed urging and got up nearing the wire. BURTON'S ANGEL angled in on the first turn and saved ground stalking the pace, bid between horses in midstretch and continued gamely between foes to the end. SMIL'N FROM ABOVE had speed between horses then angled in and set the pace inside, fought back when challenged on the second turn, inched away from that one into the stretch, then fought back again along the rail through the final furlong and was edged late. SHESKEY between horses early, stalked just off the rail then inside on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. VAADKA LOGIC five wide early, stalked three deep on the first turn then outside a rival on the backstretch, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn but weakened in the drive. QUIET ADVICE came off the rail nearing the first turn, settled off the inside, dropped back on the backstretch and second turn, was done early and was eased late. WRINKLE ROOM had a shoe put back on in the paddock before the post parade, broke out and a bit slowly, pulled and drifted out into the first turn, trailed off the rail, fell far back leaving the backstretch, was pulled up into the stretch but walked off.
