RAIN DANCER (NZ) pulled early, was in a bit tight on the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out in upper stretch and rallied under urging to gain the lead late and held. WARP off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bumped a foe in midstretch but closed gamely. ONACCOUNTOFYOU also a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and finished well outside. BOLD ROBERTA rank early, chased a bit off the rail, angled three deep into the stretch, rallied to reach even terms past midstretch, continued willingly between foes to the wire. RIVER BRIDGE (FR) four wide into the first turn, settled outside a rival or a bit off the rail, split horses in upper stretch and also finished with interest. LADY CARA five wide into the first turn, dropped back off the inside and trailed to the stretch then improved position late. ALWAYS THE LADY sped to the early lead, dueled inside, inched away on the second turn but weakened late. SALISH SLEW off a bit slowly, angled in and dueled outside a rival, briefly put a head in front on the backstretch, dropped back a bit on the second turn and weakened. LADY LEAR three deep on the first turn, chased outside, fell back in the stretch and also weakened. COLOR ME SPECIAL angled in and saved ground tracking the pace, also fell back in the stretch and had little left.
