**Footnotes**

FAVORITE FUNTIME three deep into the first turn, dueled outside a rival on that bend then inched away a bit off the rail on the backstretch, turned back the bid of SPAIN again leaving the second turn, inched away and held on gamely under urging. VERRUMA (BRZ) between horses early, was in tight approaching the first turn then steadied off heels entering that bend, saved ground tracking the pace, came out into the stretch and finished well to just miss. PRINTEMPS (CHI) bobbled slightly at the start and lagged back off the rail, swung a bit wide into the stretch and closed gamely. SPAIN between horses early, dueled inside the winner on the first turn then stalked that one along the rail, bid inside again on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. QUEENIE BELLE stalked outside a rival or between horses, came out into the stretch and also weakened. CRITIKOLA (ARG) three deep early, chased outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, angled in for the stretch and did not rally. LEADING LIGHT pulled inside early then came out into the first turn, advanced three deep on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
