DEE DEE'S DINER prompted the pace between horses on the backstretch then stalked off the rail on the turn, continued outside a rival leaving the bend and into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and wore down the pacesetter under urging. PLUS THREE awkwardly into stride, went up inside to duel for the lead, kicked clear on the turn, drifted out in the stretch and was caught late. ACLEVERSHADEOFJADE pulled her way along off the rail chasing the leaders, split horses in a bit tight into the turn, moved up inside leaving the bend, came out in upper stretch and held third. FRUITION'S JASMINE chased inside on the backstretch, went around a rival on the turn, continued inside and bested the others. CHAMP'S OLE' had good early speed and dueled between rivals, stalked three deep on the turn and between foes into the stretch and weakened. SUBLIME SLEW prompted the pace five wide then four wide on the backstretch, stalked outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. WINNING MEMORIES went up between horses to duel for the lead then stalked a bit off the rail, found the fence for the turn and gave way.
