Footnotes

BLUESTHESTANDARD moved up between horses early then dueled inside, inched away into the stretch and pulled clear under a couple taps of the whip and steady handling. SUNSET PLACE went up inside to press the early pace then stalked a bit off the rail, could not catch the winner but was second best. DENIED prompted the early pace outside then stalked outside a rival, swung four wide into the stretch and held third. LUSTY LATIN lagged back a bit off the rail without early speed, came out into the stretch and found his best stride late. WERBLIN close up between horses then a bit off the rail, angled to the fence for the turn and lacked the needed response. NO SOCKS DOC pulled his way along wide between horses early, continued outside a rival on the turn, split horses in midstretch and could not offer the necessary rally. WILD AND WISE wide early, chased outside, angled in on the turn and failed to menace. SIMONY had good early speed off the rail then dueled outside the winner, drifted out into the stretch and weakened. C. J.'S HONOUR pulled between rivals early and was in a bit tight off heels, angled to the inside on the turn and also weakened.
