PREAMBLE had speed four wide then stalked outside a rival or three deep, continued three wide on the turn and four wide into the stretch, gained the advantage outside the runner-up and drifted in some in midstretch and inched away late under left handed urging. REALITY RIDE sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in and dueled inside, came a bit off the fence into the stretch, fought back in midstretch, drifted inward in the final furlong and could not match the winner late. CRAGMONT stalked between horses or off the rail, split rivals again on the turn, came out into the stretch and edged a foe late for third. BRUTALLY HANDSOME pulled his way up inside to stalk the pace, waited a bit off heels midway on the turn, steadied in tight into the stretch and was outfinished late for the show. GAME A. P. dropped back off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. MAGIC BEAM unhurried off the inside early, angled in some on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SQUAD had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, came out some into the stretch, was between horses off heels in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong.
