Footnotes

FOG ALERT chased inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. THE HUNT IS ON settled a bit off the rail chasing the pace, went outside leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. TIZ TRUE stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the first turn, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took a short advantage into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, could not match the top pair late but held third. JOHN ELI angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch, angled out a bit off heels in midstretch, went around foes in deep stretch, angled in again and bested the others. COLOURSOFTHEGLEN (IRE) pulled his way along three deep into and on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, angled out three wide into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. TROPICAL HEAT between horses early, angled in and stalked inside, came out a bit into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and also weakened. BOULDER CREEK had speed outside a rival then inched away on the first turn and angled in, set a pressured pace along the rail, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch and also weakened.
