COO CACHOO had good early speed and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, inched clear on the second turn and proved best under some urging. IN THE PAINT stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was second best. ERBEIA between foes early, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out in midstretch and edged a rival for the show. AIN allowed to settle off the pace inside, came out into and on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and just missed third. TAMBORIM angled in and prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked just off the fence on the second turn, drifted inward in the stretch and weakened. SPRING FORTH a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail then outside a rival, split foes into the stretch and lacked a rally. CARNIVORE stalked outside a rival then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
