**Footnotes**

CONCERTO'S THUNDER sent inside to the early lead then drifted out, dueled off the rail, battled outside the runner-up into and through the stretch, responded when headed past midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. STREETS OF HEAVEN pulled between horses pressing the early pace then took back and stalked a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, bid inside in the stretch, put a head in front a sixteenth out and was outgated late. CAPT. SPARROW broke a bit slowly, chased inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. WAAFI broke in a bit, chased between horses or off the rail, came out into the stretch, angled inward in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. NITRO ACTIVE had speed four wide early, dueled three deep then outside the winner, was three wide into the stretch and weakened. WHIZER prompted the pace between horses then stalked on the backstretch, dropped back inside into the turn, came out into the stretch and gave way. FLEMINGSTOUCHOGOLD allowed to settle outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and failed to menace. EGYPT (GB) was in a good position chasing the pace outside then off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and gave way.
