Footnotes

CHOSEN MIRACLE sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, inched away inside on the hill, kicked clear and held under a strong hand ride while being flagged with the whip. EL MIRAGE KING between horses early, bid alongside the winner then stalked that one off the rail down the hill and into the stretch and held second. DETAILS R SKETCHY three deep early, chased off the rail then angled to the inside leaving the hill and picked up the show. MY SUMMER SLEW stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ROYAL F J saved ground chasing the pace, came out some into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. RAUSCHENBERG settled inside chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch and also lacked the needed late kick. SANDOR (GB) settled off the pace outside a rival to the stretch and was not a threat. MCKENZIES WAY broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
