KID DREAMS had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace, split rivals on the second turn, bid between horses a quarter mile out, gained the advantage into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and won clear under some left handed urging and steady handling late. ALEANDER chased outside a rival, moved up three deep then bid three wide a quarter mile out, could not match the winner in the drive but was clearly second best. WINE LIST pulled his way between horses to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched clear into the second turn, fought back along the rail leaving that turn and into the stretch and weakened but held third. DEAD EASY saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail in the stretch and just missed the show between rivals at the wire. MISDEED broke outward and slowly, settled off the rail then outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. AFFIRMED ARCH broke through the gate before the start, pulled his way along to press the pace outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. ANGEL CHARGE chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn and did not rally. HANDSOME DENNIS broke slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
