Footnotes

DIXIELAND BLUES chased outside or off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging then good handling late to get up nearing the wire. BIG NOTE (IRE) had good early speed the dueled briefly outside a rival, inched away and angled in on the hill, remained clear past midstretch ad held

on well but was caught late. CANDY'S SUNRISE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the hill, continued inside in the stretch and went on willingly to the wire. DEPRECIABLE was between rivals early then chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. SHAME ON ALEX pulled his way up inside the winner to press the pace, stalked just off the rail then outside a rival on the hill, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. CARBONITE broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and improved position. KINGPIN RYNO stalked outside then four wide on the hill, continued three deep leaving the hill and into the stretch and weakened. POLYTECHNICIEN a bit slow to begin, went up between horses then inside to chase the pace, came out into the stretch and also weakened. DIRTY SWAGG dropped back outside then settled outside a rival, came out in the stretch and did not rally. DISTORT THIS settled off the pace inside, came out in upper stretch and was not a threat. VERY UNUSUAL close up chasing the pace between horses down the hill, weakened in the stretch. HE'S NOT TOO SHABY stalked a bit off the rail then angled in on the hill, came out some into the stretch and broke down then unseated the rider nearing the finish. Rail on hill at zero.
