NAHEM stalked the pace outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging to get up on the line. VISUAL INTENSITY sped to the early lead, set all the pace along the inside and held on gamely through the final furlong but was edged on the wire. QUEEN'S RITE chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and bested the rest. TAPFORTEXAS angled in and stalked outside a rival to the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. ALL DE VICTORS angled in early and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. REDEMSEY was in a good position stalking the pace inside to the stretch and weakened. STAKIN STEWART a bit slow to begin, angled in early and settled off the pace along the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. WARREN'S A LEGEND angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, fell back some into the stretch and weakened.
