Footnotes

WARREN'S FLYER angled in and stalked the pace inside, slipped through along the rail into the stretch to bid for the lead, gained the advantage under urging a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed. FRIGID BRIDGET stalked off the rail then bid between horses a half mile out, battled outside a rival on the second turn, put a head in front a quarter mile out, was fanned out a bit into the stretch, battled alongside the winner through the final furlong and continued willingly. GOING FOR A SPIN chased inside then off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and just got the show. EMILY PEARL chased off the rail then angled in on the first turn, pulled her way up inside then between foes on the backstretch, bid three deep then stalked on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was edged late for third. LIFT OUR LUCK chased between foes early then off the rail, angled in some on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. NOISE OF THE CROWD broke outward and a bit slowly, settled three deep then chased outside a rival, dropped back off the rail on the second turn and lacked a further response. NASCENT pulled her way to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, was between foes into the stretch and weakened.
