Footnotes

PLAZARITA was caught three wide into the first turn, chased the pace off the rail down the backstretch, steadied sharply off heels while searching for room approaching the quarter pole, found an opening to enter the stretch three wide, took a short lead in midstretch and drew clear late. MISS BOLD TOPPER pulled on the inside around the first turn, angled outside entering the backstretch, came into the stretch five wide and rallied down the middle of the track to gain the place. GOLDEN NIP sped to the lead into the first turn, showed the way inside down the backstretch and around the second turn and weakened through the final furlong to lose the place in the late stages. KEY ALLEGRO saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside throughout and failed to mount the necessary rally. WHOLE ENCHILADA was caught three wide into the first turn, stalked three deep down the backstretch, came into the stretch four wide and weakened in the final furlong. DEPISTRY was outrun into the first turn, chased off the rail down the backstretch, remained well off the rail in the lane and passed tiring foes in the final furlong. TRULY A MIST chased the pace off the rail, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and failed to rally in the lane. ON LINE SWEETIE went into the first turn between horses, pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch, came into the stretch between foes and fell back in the stretch drive.
