### Footnotes

FUSAICHI PEGASUS stalked the pace under a hold and was briefly between foes leaving the first turn, continued off the inside, bid outside a rival on the second turn and took a short lead, then drew clear under a steady hand ride. TRIBUNAL unhurried toward the inside early, split rivals with a move forward into the second turn, came out three deep into the stretch, could not catch the winner but was second best. TOQUEVILLE broke to the outside and awkwardly, went four wide into the first turn, continued outside, moved up three deep on the second turn and a bit wider into the stretch and picked up the show. WOODEN PHONE three deep into and out of the first turn, took the lead on the backstretch, angled in, dueled inside the winner on the second turn and weakened. JEKYL AND HYDE saved ground chasing the pace, went around a rival on the second turn and gave way. NOW VOYAGER bobbled at the start, pulled his way between rivals into the first turn, continued outside a foe on the backstretch and also gave way. WING ON WING pulled a bit while sprinting to the early lead, dueled briefly inside on the backstretch, remained inside, dropped back and was done early, then was not urged in the lane.
