LINDA BELINDA close up stalking the pace three deep, bid outside the pacesetter and took command into the stretch, then pulled clear under some urging and steady handling. ENDURING GRACE settled inside, came off the rail leaving the backstretch, moved up inside leaving the second turn, came out in upper stretch, split rivals past midstretch and edged a rival for the place. PINLOCHLE angled in on the first turn and chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and just missed second. NIFTY LADY a bit slow to begin, stalked between horses, continued off the rail into the stretch and weakened. RUN FOR DESSERT was in a good position stalking the pace inside and also weakened in the stretch. FIVE NICKELS sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail into the stretch and also weakened. RED LIFESAVER chased between horses then outside leaving the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and had little left. NOR'WESTER four wide on the first turn, stalked three dedep on the backstretch, dropped back outside on the second turn and gave way.
