Footnotes

ARMENIAN SUMMER chased three deep then four wide leaving the backstretch, bid three wide on the second turn, gained the advantage into the stretch and drew clear under urging. QUITEN BOY off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground, went between horses on the backstretch, continued toward the inside on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and gained the place. WINNING TACTICS chased between foes then inside, came out three deep into the stretch, angled inward in midstretch and held third. EVERYBDYLUVSDAHEAT chased off the rail then between foes on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. THUNDERING CLOUDS saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. RANGOON RAQUETCLUB chased off the rail, bid between horses leaving the second turn to take a short lead but weakened in the stretch. SWISSLE STICK sped to the early lead, opened up on the first turn, set the pace inside, dropped back nearing the quarter pole and had little left for the stretch.
