ERBEIA angled in and settled inside then came out on the backstretch, angled out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under some urging and good handling to be along in time. BROKEN TANGO sent inside then came off the rail to stalk on the first turn, bid between horses then outside a rival, put a head in front in the stretch, fought back between foes in deep stretch and held second. DEPUTY MAX four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and edged rivals for the show. CLOSE TO THE EDGE pulled between horses and drifted out into the first turn, angled in and stalked inside as the saddle slipped forward on the backstretch, came out into the stretch, bid between foes in deep stretch and just missed third. SILK STREET had speed outside a rival then angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail, fought back from the fence on the second turn and in the stretch and was outfinished. TIR CHONAILL between horses early, chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the second turn and split foes on the wire. STEPHEN'S GOT HOPE pulled between horses to stalk the pace, continued outside a rival on the backstretch, came out into the stretch, steadied off heels in midstretch, continued between foes in deep stretch and was in tight again late. VICTORY WITH HONOR pulled his way along four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then bid three deep on the backstretch, fell back some on the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
