Footnotes

CHAMP PEGASUS steadied in tight into the first turn, chased inside, came out for room leaving the final turn, bid alongside the runner-up past midstretch and gamely prevailed under energetic handling and a late crack of the whip. BOURBON BAY stalked the leader along the inside or a bit off the rail, came out leaving the last turn, took the lead in the stretch, inched away, drifted out some in the final furlong and held on gamely but was narrowly edged late. HAIMISH HY settled inside, came out on the final turn and three deep into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and gained the show. IMPONENTE PURSE (BRZ) angled in and settled outside a rival, came out leaving the final turn and five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. JUNIPER PASS in a bit tight off heels into the first turn, was reserved inside chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) angled in and chased outside a rival then between horses leaving the backstretch and on the final turn, came out three wide into the stretch with a bid and weakened in the final furlong. RIVIERA COCKTAIL a bit slow into stride, chased outside then four wide into the stretch the first time, continued three deep, went four wide again into and on the final turn and into the stretch and weakened. INTERPATATION three deep early, stalked outside a rival then three wide leaving the backstretch, dropped back and angled in some on the last turn and also weakened. UNBRIDLE'S DREAM sped to the early lead and angled in, opened a lengthy advantage through the stretch the first time, remained clear until nearing the quarter pole, dropped back in the stretch with little left, was not returned to be unsaddled and was vanned off.
