**Footnotes**

SPEED BIAS pulled between horses then inside and steadied into the turn, came off the rail on the bend, angled out in the stretch, gained the advantage outside the pacesetter past the sixteenth pole and proved best under left handed urging. REQUISITION had speed between foes then stalked a bit off the rail, came out between horses leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and gained the place late. DIME sent inside then came outside a rival leaving the backstretch, angled out on the turn then angled in a bit into the stretch, split horses in late stretch to pick up the show. GNARLY DUDE had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, inched clear into the turn, held on well to the sixteenth pole then weakened but lost third late. CAT IN THE FOREST angled in and chased inside throughout and lacked a response in the stretch. GOT MILCH dropped back a bit off the rail early, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. PALIO PRINCE chased outside a rival then three deep between horses on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. COURTSIDE moved up between horses then chased outside, went four wide on the turn, drifted five wide into the stretch and weakened. FUTURE READINGS broke in a bit and bobbled, settled outside then off the rail, angled in on the turn and was not a factor. TOY had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, dropped back between horses on the turn, gave way and was pulled up in the stretch. CAT IN THE FOREST wore calks.
