O NECTAR broke out a bit, sped to the early lead outside foes, set the pace off the rail, angled in some on the turn and held on gamely under urging. BOONESBORO BEACH stalked the pace outside a rival, was in tight into the turn, continued tracking the winner on the bend and surged late to just miss. CHARLIES GOOD GIRL angled in and stalked inside, could not offer the needed late response but held third. GRAN AMIGA (ARG) stalked outside then three deep leaving the backstretch, continued off the rail on the turn, angled inward in the stretch and was edged for the show. BERTRANDO'S MODEL between horses early, stalked off the rail then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. ADIOS MEADOWLAKE off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came away from the rail leaving the backstretch and failed to menace. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference into the far turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to substantiate the claim.
