Footnotes

GRAND APPOINTMENT stalked the pace a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, bid outside foes and gained the lead under left handed urging three deep past the eighth pole then inched away and held while drifting out. RED WARRIOR settled along the inside, began to move up past midway on the turn, split horses a quarter mile out, swung four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. EXCESSIVEPLEASURE sped to the early lead then dueled outside a rival, put a head in front leaving the turn, battled between horses in midstretch, could not match the winner and lost second late but held third. RIDE AND SHINE settled off the rail, angled to the inside for the turn, split horses in deep stretch and finished with some interest. KOOL SUGGESTION chased inside then a bit off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch, went between foes in late stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. SHADOW OF ILLINOIS went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. BILO stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. MCMANUS between horses early, chased outside a rival, also came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPENCER'S MAGIC squeezed a bit just after the start, settled outside, came four wide into the stretch and was not a factor.
