MISTO QUENTE (BRZ) chased between horses or outside a rival, moved up outside on the second turn, took the lead three deep a quarter mile out, kicked clear and held under urging. JOHNNY RED KERR angled in unhurried then raced outside a rival on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. MACDUFF (GB) settled outside then three deep, was in tight between foes into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and also rallied. COSMONAUT angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the second turn, lacked room into the stretch, split rivals in the drive and finished with interest. ORBITS WORLD angled in and saved ground off the pace, split rivals into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and was outfinished. TAKE A CHANCE stalked off the rail, was between horses leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. CHARBONNIER saved ground stalking the pace, came out for room leaving the second turn, split horses into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LIKE A TIGER angled in and chased inside, steadied in tight into the second turn and could not summon the necessary response. MASTER DAVID stalked off the rail, bid outside a rival into the second turn and between foes leaving that bend and weakened. LEGAL LOGIC chased outside a rival then three deep, steadied between foes in traffic on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the

necessary rally. SHIMBY (CHI) chased between horses, dropped back in traffic on the second turn and weakened. IMITATION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, steadied while weakening into the stretch and dropped back.
