LUCKY J. H. sped between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside or a bit off the rail, inched away again leaving the second turn and drew off under a couple cracks of the whip and steady handling. BONANZA TWO close up stalking the pace inside to the stretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. GO COYOTE JOE chased toward the inside, came out into the stretch and bested the others. KING OF L. A. stalked outside a rival then bid outside the winner on the backstretch, continued between horses on the second turn and weakened. CHEKHOV settled outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch and improved position. HAMMER BACK off a bit slowly, angled in and settled inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MEN ONLY stalked the pace outside then three deep on the second turn and weakened in the lane. WOODEN TICKET broke slowly, angled in and settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. GROUND CONTROL chased outside a rival then just off the rail, came outside a foe into the stretch and had little left. BUREAUCRATIC a bit washy at the gate, saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
