Footnotes

THE FIREBIRD chased off the rail then a bit off the fence on the turn, came out nearing the quarter pole and three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to prove best. LONGITUDE broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail or outside, advanced three and four wide on the turn to gain the lead a quarter mile out, kicked clear but could not hold off the winner. BEAN WHO settled off the inside, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn, was fanned seven wide into the stretch and gained the show late. RICKY EL CORREDOR unhurried inside on the backstretch and into the turn, came out leaving the bend and three deep into the stretch, drifted in and was edged for third. CLEAR THE HALL allowed to settle off the rail, went outside on the turn and six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BEAR MOUNTAIN chased off the rail, split rivals on the turn, steadied in a bit tight nearing the quarter pole, came out four wide into the stretch and did not rally. DREWISMYSON forced the pace three deep then stalked outside, was in tight leaving the turn and fanned five wide into the stretch and weakened. BUILT FOR THEDERBY had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and weakened in the stretch. I LIKE BLACKHAWKS dueled between horses then outside a rival, dropped back in the stretch and gave way. A claim of foul by the rider of BEAR MOUNTAIN against the winner for alleged interference leaving the turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
