**Footnotes**

FACE AND AN ACE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back leaving the turn and through a stiff drive and gamely prevailed under some left handed urging. FANDINO pulled his way along to stalk the early pace, bid between horses then dueled outside the winner leaving the hill and through the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. WASH PARK chased inside, came off the rail in the stretch and bested the others. JUNIPER PASS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then angled in on the hill, came out into the stretch, angled in again and lacked the needed late kick. FYVIO hopped and bobbed some at the start, dueled outside a rival then three deep, stalked off the rail leaving the hill, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. LETS GO INDIAN stalked outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and also weakened. BATTLE SCHOOL settled outside then off the rail, angled inward in the stretch and did not rally. ROCK SOLID KING hesitated then broke inward and slowly, settled off the rail, angled in on the hill, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. SILVER STYLE settled outside then alongside a rival leaving the hill and into the stretch and lacked a rally. DISTORTED ECONOMY broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then just off the rail and was outrun. MONITOR PASS broke slowly, settled inside, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
