CITY TO CITY stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival, continued just off the inside leaving the second turn, bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch, gained the lead past midstretch and proved best under left handed urging. CAMILLE C sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late and just held second. ANDINA (IRE) stalked inside then between foes leaving the backstretch, split horses leaving the second turn and finished with interest to just miss the place. IN THE SLIPS chased outside a rival, went between foes leaving the backstretch and was shuffled back in a bit tight early on the turn, steadied behind rivals into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BAB AT THE BOWSTER (IRE) pulled her way along inside to stalk the pace, moved up on the backstretch, fell back a bit on the second turn, continued inside and could not offer the necessary late kick. ORCHESTRATOR angled in and chased outside a rival then between foes leaving the backstretch, continued three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and also lacked the needed response in the stretch. DISLITLELITEOMINE broke in a bit, settled off the rail, went outside foes leaving the backstretch and four wide into the second turn, continued off the rail, angled in leaving that turn and had little left for the stretch.
