Footnotes

BARON VON RED sped to the early lead and angled over, dueled on the inside into and around the turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch, felt a couple of cracks of the whip while drawing away in midstretch and was under steady hand urging to the wire. THIRTEEN BLACK broke slowly to be away behind his field, angled outside down the backstretch, rallied down the middle of the track in the final furlong to gain the place in the final yards. TWO PARTS dueled outside the winner into and around the turn, could not go with that one at the top of the stretch, veered out in upper stretch and back in from the whip nearing the sixteenth pole while racing greenly and lost the place late. STONEWALL JACKSON broke inward and bumped a rival at the start, chased off the rail to the lane, angled inside for the stretch drive and lacked the necessary rally. SURELY SWIFT stalked outside the dueling pacesetters into the turn, began to lose ground around the turn and fell back through the lane. RIVERSMITH stumbled at the start and bumped a rival, moved up on the inside down the backstretch, began to weaken on the turn and gave way. DANG YOU CACTUS steadied between horses at the start, angled outside, pulled up shortly after leaving the chute and was vanned off.
