TO THE TOP had speed between horses then angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. TIABELLE pulled between horses then a bit off the rail, was in a bit tight off heels a half mile out and again into the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and bested the others. CHA DA BOOM well placed stalking the pace inside, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened. IVA ATTITUDE a bit slow into stride, chased inside, came off the rail on the turn, angled out into the stretch and did not rally. RIGHT SMART SECRET allowed to settle off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and failed to menace.
