Footnotes

CAMBINA (IRE) settled off the rail then three deep leaving the hill, came out five wide into the stretch and rallied under some urging and strong handling to get up late. QUIET OASIS (IRE) chased outside or off the rail, came out leaving the hill and five wide into the stretch, bid three deep to gain the lead, kicked clear and held on well but was caught on the line. CATHY'S CRUNCHES between foes early, chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and bested the rest. CLONEYLASS (IRE) between rivals early, settled outside a rival then inside, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and improved position. RIGOLETTA stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and weakened. TRUE WAY OF GRACE settled off the rail then outside a rival on the hill, angled inward in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHE'LL HEIR close up stalking the pace outside a rival, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch and weakened. DAWNIE MACHO dueled outside a rival, kicked clear between calls on the hill and angled in, battled inside leaving the hill and into the stretch, fought back in midstretch, then weakened. TEDDY'S PROMISE broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then angled in and saved ground to no avail. ADVANTAGE PLAYER prompted the pace inside DAWNIE MACHO early, had that one slip away on the hill, re-bid alongside that rival leaving the hill and weakened in the stretch. LATIN LASHES settled outside then chased three deep on the hill, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
