REVILLEW SLEW angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, swung three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up in the final stride. SEARCH FOR TRIPLE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the rail, inched away leaving the second turn and held on well but was caught on the wire. ZONAL FLOW saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the rest. DARE BUNNY allowed to settle outside a rival, came out into the stretch and had a mild bid. NO ETAL saved ground unhurried to the stretch, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. REBUILD TRUST pulled her way along inside early, came off the rail leaving the first turn and stalked the pace, bid outside the leader between calls into the second turn but weakened in the stretch. OUR SHARON STONE allowed to settle in midpack off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the backstretch and also weakened in the lane.
