SUNDAY BREAK (JPN) had good early speed and stalked the leader a bit off the rail, bid outside that one into and on the second turn, took a short lead nearing midstretch, battled under urging to deep stretch then inched away late. RAVEN POWER broke out a bit, went up outside the winner to take command in the run to the first turn, angled in on that bend, set the pace inside, fought back through the stretch but could not match strides late while holding second. AZILLION (IRE) close up stalking the pace three deep then outside a rival on the second turn, continued off the rail into the stretch and made a late run at the place. HOT CONTEST saved ground tracking the leader, came out leaving the second turn and lacked the needed response. GOLD DOLLAR well placed between horses early, chased outside a rival or off the rail and weakened.
