MILWAUKEEBREW KAROO stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage outside foes in midstretch and proved best under some urging. DISTINCTIVE AFLEET pulled his way up to press the pace inside and was in a bit tight on the backstretch, stalked just off the rail on the turn, re-bid between horses into the stretch and continued willingly to hold second. FOLLOWS NONE chased outside then off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, continued along the fence in the stretch and picked up the show. DYNAQUAKE had good early speed outside the runner-up, inched away and angled in on the backstretch, fought back a bit off the rail in the stretch, was between foes in deep stretch and weakened late. KHUN DAN hopped in a slow start, settled just off the inside, came out in the stretch and was outrun.
