Footnotes

SPRING HOUSE saved ground stalking the pace, came out in upper stretch, split rivals with a bid past midstretch to gain the lead, kicked clear under urging and held. CHURCH SERVICE broke slowly, settled inside then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the last turn, came out in the stretch and finished fast to take the place late. ATTEMPTED HUMOR chased outside a rival or off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied between foes late. BONJOUR (NZ) close up stalking the pace while saving ground, came out into the stretch and finished with interest between horses. MEDICI CODE (GB) settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and also went between horses nearing the wire. ZAMBEZI SUN (GB) pulled his way along to stalk the pace outside a rival, bid alongside KRIS SILVER on the backstretch, briefly put a head in front into the second turn, dueled alongside that rival, was between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. LIGHTNING HIT (IRE) chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. OBRIGADO (FR) settled off the pace outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed late kick. KRIS SILVER took the early lead and set the pace inside, dueled along the fence on the backstretch and second turn, had the rider lose the whip in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch but weakened in the final furlong. MR. UNIVERSO (BRZ) three deep on the hill, angled in and chased outside a rival, was between horses on the second turn and lacked a further response. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
