Footnotes

IRON JOE T stalked on the outside behind the dueling leaders down the backstretch, came into the stretch four wide, bid outside the runner-up in midstretch and was up for the score in the final yards. ET TU WALKER dueled for the lead on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, battled a bit off the rail through the final furlong and was caught in the final yards. MAGIC BEAM chased the pace off the rail down the backstretch, angled towards the rail on the turn, came out at the top of the lane, angled back in nearing the wire and held the show. MR. WHY WHY dueled four wide down the backstretch and stalked three deep on the turn, came into the stretch three wide and weakened between horses in the final furlong. SIR HAMILTON chased inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, came out at the top of the stretch, drifted out leaving the furlong marker and did not threaten. CLINTON dueled for the lead three deep on the backstretch, dropped back between horses on the turn, came out in the lane and weakened. WILLIE BROWN dueled between horses down the backstretch and outside a rival around the turn, came into the stretch between horses and gave way between foes in the final furlong.
