### Footnotes

TRES BORRACHOS sent inside to duel for the lead, took a short advantage into the second turn, inched away briefly leaving that turn, fought back when headed along the rail in midstretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. HOORAYFORHOLLYWOOD bobbled at the start, raced close up stalking the pace off the rail, bid three deep leaving the second turn and outside the winner into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch and continued willingly but was outgamed. SKY KINGDOM chased just off the rail, swung out three wide into the stretch and gained the show. GALLANT FIELDS chased outside a rival then off the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. KEY DECISION (ARG) had speed between horses then dueled outside the winner, was in a bit tight between horses into the stretch, angled in and weakened.
