INDIAN SUN pulled his way between horses then chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and closed willingly under urging to get up in the final stride. RIVERGRADE BOY prompted the pace outside a rival, took the lead into the stretch, fought back toward the inside through the drive and held on well but was caught on the line. NSYNC LYNX three deep early, stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up through the stretch and just saved the show between foes late. GHETTO (GB) chased three deep then outside a rival, went three wide again on the second turn and into the stretch and went on willingly between horses at the wire. SHORE DO chased between foes then outside a rival, came out in the stretch, split horses in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. GRASBERG saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, lacked room off heels from midstretch to deep stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. ROBSCARVIC (IRE) between horses early, stalked inside, came out a bit into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed response. SPINNING SOUND (IRE) sent to the early lead along the rail, dueled inside to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
