Footnotes

KEY VISTA had speed three deep then inched away leaving the backstretch, angled in early on the turn and kicked clear and remained clear in the stretch under some left handed urging. BLUSHING MARTHA bobbed slightly at the start, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and gained the place. THERMAL NERMAL chased a bit off the rail then stalked outside a rival on the turn and in the stretch and edged that one for the show. TWELVE FOLDS had good early speed to duel then stalk the pace along the rail, continued inside in the stretch and was edged for third. WOEBEGON had speed between foes then stalked outside a rival, steadied between horses early on the turn and again off heels past the three eighths pole, angled in approaching the stretch and weakened. SISTER ESPERANZA a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then a bit off the fence on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
