Footnotes

GILBOA (FR) advanced from along the fence in the middle stages, came off the rail and challenged on the final bend, forged to the front, kicked clear and comfortably held. BUSHRA bobbled at the break and was bumped, saved ground to the stretch, angled out and close stoutly from the outside. BEAUTIFUL FACE unhurried early, launched rally into the final turn, split foes, lacked room past midstretch, angled out late and was up for the show. CIRCA broke a step slow and was bumped, recovered to prompt the pace from the inside, came out a bit into the lane and only gave ground grudgingly late. BLUE EYED LILLI followed the winner's path on the backstretch, loomed on the final turn but failed to sustain bid in the lane. FIAMMA (IRE) content to settle well off the pace, saved ground to the stretch, came out a bit, lacked room but still improved position late. DESTINA stepped to the front while crossing over to the rail, relinquished control into the stretch and retreated. KICKEN GRASS angled out and raced wide on the backstretch and failed to menace. GIVEN THE NOD stalked the pacesetter on a two wide path before tiring.
