Footnotes

SHUFFLING KID (GB) sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, drifted out into the stretch but held on gamely under urging. RED BRIAR (IRE) unhurried early, split rivals on the hill, came out into the stretch and rallied gamely between foes late. DARK SORCERER (GB) chased outside then four wide down the hill, came out into the stretch and also closed gamely. ROMAN DANCER close up chasing three deep down the hill and into the stretch and also put in a late bid. HOLDTHEHELM stumbled and steadied sharply at the start, saved ground off the pace, came out for the stretch and also found his best stride late. DOC HOLIDAY (IRE) stalked the leader between horses early then inside down the hill and was outfinished. SWEET STEPPER saved ground chasing the pace, was steadied and shuffled back on the hill and lacked the needed response. LORD FHAZIO hopped at the start, settled outside then four wide down the hill and failed to menace. ROAD TO JUSTICE (GB) steadied after the start, moved up inside then came out on the hill and a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary late kick. IRISH VALE (GB) close up off the rail early, chased between horses, dropped back leaving the hill and weakened. WILD CELEBRATION unhurried off the rail then outside a rival, dropped back between horses leaving the hill and was not a threat. EXPECTED PROGRAM pulled his way between horses then stalked inside, dropped back into the stretch, steadied in upper stretch and had nothing left.
