Footnotes

STARSPANGLED HEAT settled off the rail then angled in and saved ground down the hill, split horses into the stretch, found the fence in midstretch, rallied under urging to the lead inside in deep stretch and held gamely. CIRCA'SGOLDENGEAR chased off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch, drifted out a bit under left handed urging past midstretch, bid between foes in deep stretch and continued willingly. STAR NICHOLAS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside the winner, came three wide into the stretch, angled out and closed gamely four wide on the line. EARNEDNEVERGIVEN sped to the early lead inside a rival, set the pace a bit off the rail, kicked clear in the stretch, fought back between foes in deep stretch and continued on gamely to the end. INTUITIVE NATURE settled off the rail then a bit off the fence, came out three deep into the stretch, bid between horses past midstretch, steadied in tight a sixteenth out and fell back late. PREFERRED MANDATE had speed outside a rival then stalked just off the rail, dropped back between foes in the stretch and weakened. LOS BOMBEROS broke slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail leaving the hill, dropped back in upper stretch and had little left for the drive. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run through deep stretch but made no change when they ruled the trouble to INTUITIVE NATURE did not alter the original order of finish. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
