Footnotes

TAKE NO PRISONERS stalked between horses or a bit off the rail, rallied under urging between foes to gain the lead nearing the wire and proved best. DREAM CAUGHT between horses early, stalked outside, moved up on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid three wide in late stretch and continued willingly to the end. YOU KNOW I KNOW went up inside to stalk the pace, bid along the rail on the turn, took a short lead in the stretch, inched a way in midstretch and held on well but was caught late. BLAZING MARINO between horses early, fell back off the rail, split rivals nearing the half mile pole, continued outside on the turn and lacked the needed late kick. AWESOME MIKE wide early, had speed four wide then inched away on the backstretch, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled outside a foe on the turn and into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. CHIBITA settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went around a foe leaving the turn and did not rally. GIVIMAWAY had speed between foes then stalked three deep or a bit off the rail, found the inside on the turn and weakened in the drive. CATCANSCAT also had speed between horses then stalked outside a rival, dropped back between foes on the turn and gave way, then was eased late.
