Footnotes

INCLUDE THE CAT chased off the rail around the first turn and on the outside down the backstretch, went into the second turn three deep, remained three wide around the turn and into the stretch, rallied on through the final furlong, took the lead inside the sixteenth marker and held. MINER'S DAUGHTER pulled a bit between horses around the first turn, pressed the pace on the outside to the lane, battled the pacesetter through the final furlong, was between horses late and held the place. TWELVE FOLDS was sent to the lead on the inside into the first turn, inched clear around the turn, set the pace on the inside to the stretch, battled back when challenged in midstretch, lost the place but was a clear third at the wire. TOOMANYTOMATOES broke out at the start, settled off the rail around the first turn, went into the second turn between horses, angled towards the inside in the lane but did not rally. MIA ISABEL saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, came out for the drive and lacked a bid in the final furlong. PINK BLOSSOM was caught three wide around the first turn, stalked off the rail down the backstretch, bid three deep a half mile out, dropped back between horses on the second turn and gave way in the final furlong.
