GONE COURTING sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, inched away on the second turn, and gamely met the bid of the runner-up, then pulled clear late under strong handling. DARING GENERAL bobbled at the start, angled in and saved ground unhurried, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some approaching midstretch, bid outside the winner but could not match that one late. IRISHEYESAREFLYING saved ground not far back, moved up between horses on the second turn, waited a bit leaving that bend, steadied briefly in a bit tight off heels nearing midstretch and could not offer the needed rally when clear but got the show. DESERT BLOOMER pulled his way along inside stalking the pace, waited a bit along the rail leaving the second turn and also could not summon the needed late response. FLYAWAY JACK broke out and slowly, settled outside, moved up three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, continued three deep between foes into the stretch but could not sustain the bid in the drive. PRIZED DEMON three deep into the first turn, chased the leaders outside, split horses leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. HYRAH went up on the first turn and forced the pace outside the winner, also dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
