CAFE KATY unhurried inside early, moved up outside a rival into the second turn, continued inside on that turn, came out into the stretch, bid three deep under urging to gain the lead past midstretch and pulled clear. CATCATCAT saved ground chasing the pace, went outside a rival on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and gained the place late. KEYSTONE MALIBU dueled outside a rival, was between foes briefly on the backstretch, continued inside, took an awkward step into the second turn, fought back along the rail on that bend and to midstretch, could not match the winner and lost second late. CHARMING EILEEN chased off the rail, bid three deep on the backstretch, dueled outside a rival, also was no match for the winner in the final furlong and was edged for a minor award between foes late. THUNDER LADY settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked a further response. DANSE KONGO angled in and dueled inside, stalked along the rail on the backstretch, dropped back into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
