Footnotes

CHANEL ISLANDS sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, kicked clear on the second turn and proved best under urging. ROMANESQUE stalked outside a rival or between horses, came out four wide into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. REDMEANSGO angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out into the second turn, swung five wide into the stretch and just missed second on the far outside. SO HAPPY TOGETHER saved ground stalking the pace, remained inside and lacked the needed late kick. RUNWAY LOLLIPOP (ARG) bobbed slightly at the start, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, was between foes into the stretch and weakened. ETOILE PETITE angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch and lacked the necessary response. CUSCO (IRE) stalked outside a rival or between horses, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. THREE TIMES A LADY (NZ) angled in and was in a bit tight early, saved ground off the pace and did not rally. MAEMY (BRZ) was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, dropped back outside a rival on the second turn and weakened.
