HASTY KRIS sent inside to stalk the pace, awaited room on the turn, split rivals leaving the bend, bid inside in the stretch, gained the advantage under urging past midstretch, inched clear in deep stretch and held gamely. HARVARD AVENUE chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. PERFECT MOON dueled outside a rival, took a short lead leaving the turn, battled between horses in midstretch, could not quite match the top pair late but held third. CHOCTAW NATION unhurried along the inside early, swung out into the stretch, angled in through the drive and finished with interest. OCEANUS (BRZ) allowed to settle outside a rival then off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. MASS MEDIA close up stalking the pace outside the winner, bid three deep into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. DEL MAR SHOW stalked the pace off the rail on the backstretch and most of the turn, dropped back leaving the turn and gave way. SINISTER G had good early speed and dueled inside, fell back into the stretch and also gave way.
