Footnotes

THE RYE MAN angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging, brushed with the runner-up late and gamely prevailed. ALEC settled three deep, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied to a short lead past midstretch, brushed with the winner late and was edged. MANDILON chased off the rail, advanced four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch to gain command, inched away, fought back past midstretch and just held third. HE'S DELIRIOUS saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, lacked room behind rivals in midstretch, came out and just missed the show. SUPER COVER four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, drifted inward in deep stretch and lacked the needed response. RENKER had good early speed and duled inside, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. BETHUNE washy at the gate, prompted the pace outside a rival, took a short lead leaving the second turn, was between foes into the stretch, weakened and steadied when crowded in deep stretch. DEVANATOR unhurried outside a rival then between foes, angled in on the second turn, came out in the stretch and did not rally. HOWDO rank and steadied early, stalked outside a rival or between foes, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run between the top pair but made no change when they ruled both runners contributed to the light contact between them.
