Footnotes

VAUNDELL chased outside then off the rail, went four wide into the stretch, rallied under some urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. CHARLIE AND CHRIS close up chasing the pace outside rivals, went four wide on the turn and three deep into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch and gained the place. COMPARI had speed a bit off the rail, stalked inside then off the fence, bid between horses in the drive and bested the rest. MOUNTAIN GUIDE sped between horses to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then angled in, fought back in midstretch but weakened in the final furlong. TAMARACK SMARTY angled in on the backstretch and saved ground chasing the pace, cut the corner into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPENDAMILLIONBUX settled a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. PAPOOSE LA MOOSE broke a bit slowly, settled off the inside then angled in, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. ABSOLUTLYPOSITIVLY chased inside then a bit off the rail, steadied midway on the backstretch, moved up along the rail into the turn and weakened in the stretch. BIG CITY BERNIE stalked between horses then three deep into the turn, dropped back between foes leaving the turn and gave way.
